**for enrolment of students to doctoral studies in CIVIL ENGINEERING
in the academic year of 2021/2022**

Chapter I

1. The Faculty enrolls students to **university postgraduate studies for acquiring the academic title of doctor of science** for the field of technical sciences. The studies comprise several research areas in the field of Civil Engineering and Fundamental Technical Sciences.
2. Students may enrol to studies lasting three years (full-time studies) or to four-year studies with an extended duration of research work (part-time studies).
3. Eligible for enrolment are students who have:
 - completed university graduate studies or university undergraduate studies in civil engineering
 - completed university graduate studies and university undergraduate studies in the area of technical sciences and in the fields related to civil engineering, and who have obtained at least 60 ECTS credits from courses belonging to the field of civil engineering (applicants who have not achieved the required number of ECTS credits must pass differential exams determined by the Science Committee)
 - acquired a master's degree in science according to the previous regulations, and the Science Committee may recognize completed obligations that correspond to the obligations of the study program in which they enrol.
4. Candidates must have a minimum average grade of 3.5 (aggregate average grade for undergraduate and graduate studies).

Candidates must be proficient in written and spoken English language.

To be eligible for enrolment, the candidates must provide a recommendation from a prospective mentor, and a general description or working title of a wider area to be covered by the doctoral thesis.

An interview with candidates is an obligatory part of the enrolment procedure.
5. In exceptional cases, candidates with a lower average grade will also be allowed to enrol if they are able to present additional recommendations from two university lecturers (one of whom must be the graduate studies mentor), and if they are co-authors of at least one paper presented at a congress/conference or published in a journal. If the graduate studies mentor is also the prospective mentor for doctoral studies, the candidate must present an additional recommendation (three recommendations in total).

6. Number of available places: **30 places in total**. If the number of candidates exceeds the number of available places, a selection procedure will be conducted, during which several elements will be considered (average grade, completion of postgraduate studies – specialist or master’s degree studies, publication of papers, patents, awards, research interests shown during the interview).
7. Education costs amount to HRK 60,000.00 (8.000,00 EUR) for the full time studies, and HRK 80,000.00 (10.500,00 EUR) for the part time studies.

Chapter II

Applications for enrolment can be submitted in the period from **1 June to 1 September 2021**. The applications must be sent by standard mail to the following address: University of Zagreb, Faculty of Civil Engineering, Office for postgraduate studies, Kaciceva 26, Zagreb, Croatia, but may also be submitted in person to the Faculty’s secretariat, room 208, courtyard building. The following documents must be submitted with the application form:

- brief curriculum vitae with the list of published research and professional papers
- certificate of Croatian nationality, i.e. certificate of nationality for foreign nationals
- birth certificate
- diploma on completion of undergraduate/graduate university studies, i.e. diploma on completion of postgraduate studies
- decision on approval of foreign higher education qualification (for foreign nationals)

- certificate on examinations passed
- Educational plan and program for previously completed studies (for candidates who have not completed their previous studies at the Faculty of Civil Engineering of the University of Zagreb)
- Research Theme Proposal (form)
- published papers (if any)

As an exception, graduate studies students may submit the application only, but are required to submit the above documents by the time of enrolment to the studies.
